# (THE BOROUGH OF MAIDSTONE) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) VARIATION No.10 ORDER 2018

### **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 53 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

### REVOCATION, MODICATION AND AMENDMENTS

- 1. The Kent County Council (Borough of Maidstone) (Waiting Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2017 ("the Order of 2017") to be amended as follows;
- 2. The Order of 2017 shall have effect as though
  - (i) In Schedule 1 thereto, the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order were inserted.

#### In the Schedules to the Order:

## SCHEDULE STREET OR LENGTH OF STREET WHERE WAITING IS PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME

### Roads in Boughton Monchelsea in the Borough of Maidstone

In Schedule 1 of the Order of 2017 the following shall be inserted in the correct alphabetical and numerical order

CHURCH HILL On the eastern side from a point 62 metres south of its junction with Heath Road in a north-westerly direction then in an easterly direction for

distance of 69 metres

CHURCH STREET (4) On the eastern side from its junction with Heath Road in a northerly

direction for 24.5 metres

HEATH ROAD (1) On the northern side

(c) From its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 176 metres

### CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

3. This Order maybe cited as 'The Kent County Council (The Borough of Maidstone) (Waiting Restrictions) Variation No.10 Order 2018' and shall come into operation on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 2018.
