ORDER 2003

The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the Act of 1984) and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 8th day of July 2003 and may be cited as the "Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council" A483 Fabian Way and B4290 Ashleigh Terrace Jersey Marine Order 2003
2.
 - (i) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
 - (ii) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The provisions of any existing Speed Limit Orders made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (or under any enactment which preceded that Act) are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule of this Order.
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule of this Order.

SCHEDULE

50mph Speed Restriction Order

i) A483 Fabian Way, Swansea

From a point approx. 50 metres east of its junction with the B4290 Ashleigh Terrace in a westerly direction to the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council and the City and County of Swansea Council boundary (a distance of approx. 2.3km).

ii) B4290 Ashleigh Terrace, Jersey Marine

From its junction with the A483 Fabian Way to a point 50 metres north along Ashleigh Terrace.
