WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(BETHANY SQUARE, STATION ROAD, HIGH STREET AND LLEWELLYN STREET,
PORT TALBOT) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING), (LIMITED WAITING)
(PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) AND (REVOCATION) ORDER 1980

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84 D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84 C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 11 day of FEBRUARY, 1980 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Bethany Square, Station Road, High Street and Llewellyn Street, Port Talbot) (Prohibition of Waiting), (Limited Waiting), (Prohibition of Entry) and (Revocation) Order, 1980".

2. In this Order -

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority complying with the requirement of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (B.S. 4631: 1970) coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins; and

"relevant position" means -

- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen;
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle.
3. The undermentioned Traffic Regulation Orders are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the lengths of the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order:-
 - (i) The Council of the Borough of Port Talbot Station Road (Bethany Square) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967 made on the 11th day of October, 1967.
 - (ii) The Council of the Borough of Port Talbot Station Road (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1968 made on the 8 day of October, 1968.

4. Save as provided in Articles 6 and 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause any vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

5. Save as provided in Articles 6 and 7 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause any vehicle to wait for longer than one hour, return prohibited within two hours, on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this Order between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. from Monday to Saturday inclusive.

6. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely -
 - (i) building, industrial, or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the side of road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said side of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1978; or
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (f) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said sides of roads.

7. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, had marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the side of road referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road).

8. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter the Llewellyn Street Access Road from the Multi-Storey Car Park at its junction with Pentyla Road, Baglan.

9. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967 or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULE 1

Bethany Square (South Side)

From the western side of the Station Road service lane for a distance of 25 metres in a westerly direction.

Station Road (Eastern Side)

From a point 22 metres from the southern kerb line of Bethany Square for a distance of 55 metres in a south easterly direction.

Station Road (West Side)

From a point in line with the northern kerb line of Margam Terrace for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

From the terminal point of the existing "No Waiting and No Loading" Order on the south side of Margam Terrace for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

No Waiting at Any Time

High Street (West Side)

From a point in line with the southern kerb line of the former Water Street for a distance of 52 metres in a northerly direction and then for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction across the carriageway of High Street.

Station Road (West Side)

From a point in line with the northern kerb line of Margam Terrace for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

From the terminal point of the existing No Waiting and No Loading Order on the south side of Margam Terrace for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

SCHEDULE 3

Limited Waiting - One Hour - Between 8.00 A.M. and 6.00 P.M.
Monday to Saturday

Bethany Square (South Side)

From the western side of the Station Road service lane for a distance of 25 metres in a westerly direction.

Station Road (Eastern Side)

From a point 22 metres from the southern kerb line of Bethany Square for a distance of 55 metres in a south easterly direction.
