WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL(BWLCH ROAD, CIMLA)(REVOCATION OF ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER, 1977

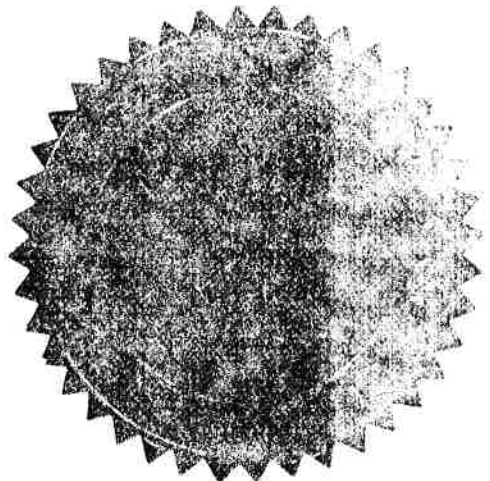
The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2), (3) and 24D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84 C(1) of the said Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

- (i) This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd day of November 1977, and maybe cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Bwlch Road, Cimla) (Revocation of One Way Traffic) Order 1977".
- (ii) The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (iii) Article 1 of the "West Glamorgan County Council (Bwlch Road, Cimla) (One Way Traffic) Order 1976" made by the West Glamorgan County Council on the 15 March 1976 is hereby revoked in respect of the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

For a length of 40 metres along Bwlch Road in an easterly direction from its junction with the road running along the South side of Cimla Common.
