(HERBERT STREET, PONTARDAWE) (LIMITED WAITING) (DISABLED PARKING ONLY) AND (REVOCATION)

ORDER 2010

The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 45, 46, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The Act of 1984") and of all other powers it enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of June 2010 and may be cited as the "Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Herbert Street, Pontardawe) (Limited Waiting) (Disabled Parking Only) and (Revocation) Order 2010".
- 2. (1) In this Order -
 - "Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000;
 - "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000;
 - "Parking Disc" means a parking disc issued by a Local Authority capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;
 - "Relevant Position" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000;
 - "Disabled Parking Place" means an area of highway designated as a parking place by Schedule 3 of this Order for use by Disabled Persons Vehicles;
 - "Public Services Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 and "local service" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Transport Act 1985;
 - "Universal Service Providers" means those operators of postal services who are licensed to provide all or part of a Universal Postal Service under the provisions contained in the Postal Services Act 2000.

- Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule (2)bearing that number in this Order.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament. (3)
- Article 14 and Schedule 8 of the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Herbert Street and Holly Street, Pontardawe) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading or Unloading) (Prohibition of Waiting) (One Way Traffic) (Limited Waiting) (Taxi Rank) (Parking by Service Vehicles) and (Revocations) Order 3. 1997 are hereby revoked.
 - Any existing waiting, loading or unloading restrictions are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this 4. Order.
 - Save as provided in Articles 7, 8, 9 and 10 of this Order no person except at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait for more than 1 hour or to return within 2 5. hours to the same side and length of road on which that period of waiting occurred between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day except Sunday on the sides and lengths of roads as set out in Schedule 1 of this Order.
 - Save as provided in Articles 7, 8 and 10 of this Order or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to park in the Disabled Parking Place designated in 6. Schedule 2 of this Order unless that vehicle is a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Persons Badge.
 - Nothing in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides and lengths of roads specified therein 7. for so long as may be necessary to enable: -
 - A person to board or alight from a vehicle; (A)
 - The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following (B) operations, namely:_
 - Building, industrial or demolition operations; (i)
 - The removal of any obstruction to traffic; (ii)
 - The laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said side and length of road of any sewer or of any main (iii) pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (C) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (D) The vehicle to be used for the purpose of deliveries or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (E) Public Service Vehicles operating a local service when waiting at an authorised bus stop to set down or pick up passengers, or to school buses.
- 8. Nothing in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides and lengths of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle.
- 9. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge to wait on the side and length of road referred to in the said Article.
 - 10. The prohibitions imposed by Articles 5 and 6 of this Order shall not apply to Police, Fire, Ambulance or other Emergency Service vehicles or to Local Authority vehicles when in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.

SCHEDULES

Schedule 1 – Waiting Limited to 1 Hour Return Prohibited within 2 Hours 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday

Herbert Street - (South Side)

Between points approximately 122 metres and 143 metres south east of its junction with Holly Street.

Schedule 2 – Disabled Bay Blue Badge Holders Only At Any Time Herbert Street (South Side)

From a point opposite the southern kerbline of Holly Street for a distance of approximately 19 metres in a north westerly direction.
