

WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(NEW ACCESS ROAD OFF B4434 TO CAM GEARS LTD., RESOLVEN)

(PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 1977

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(3A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1967, as amended") and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 as amended and all other powers them enabling hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person other than those specified in Article 2 hereunder shall proceed along the length of the new access road to Cam Gears Ltd., Resolven for a distance of 475 metres in a south westerly direction from the junction with Route B.4434.
2. Nothing in this Order shall be interpreted so as to relate to foot passengers using the section of the highway for the purposes of maintenance of the highway and all services therein, the access by the Police and emergency services and authorised officials including drivers of vehicles which have broken down.
3. The interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of April 1977, and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (New Access Road, Off B4434 to Cam Gears Ltd., Resolven) (Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 1977".
