**THE SEVENOAKS DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
AMENDMENT NO.2 ORDER 2010**

The District Council of Sevenoaks in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 32, 35 and 124 and Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf, and with the consent of the County Council of Kent, and after all consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

(1) The Sevenoaks District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2008 shall have effect as though:

a) the Schedule hereto were substituted for the Schedule thereto in its entirety;

b) the following were added to Article 3:

3.21 No vehicle shall be left in a disabled parking bay unless a disabled person's badge relating to a person using that vehicle is displayed in the relevant position.

3.22 Any parking bay signed for the use for a certain type of vehicle, i.e. a coach or a bus, etc., shall only be used for parking the type of vehicle indicated.

c) the following were substituted for Article 6 in its entirety:

6 Permits

6.1 Residents' Permits: the Council may issue residents' permits to residents living in the vicinity of certain parking places, subject to availability, as specified column 7 of the Schedule hereto and at the charges shown therein. Such permits shall only be valid for the parking place specified unless otherwise confirmed by the Council in writing.

6.2 Permits related to school use: where permits are issued either directly by the Council or by a school with the Council's written authorisation, to enable parents of school children to park for the relevant period agreed, the requirement to purchase and display a pay and display ticket will not apply whilst the vehicle is parked within the time period stipulated. Such permits shall be displayed in the relevant position.

6.3 Permits for Sencio Community leisure staff: permits issued by Sencio Community Leisure will entitle its staff to park in the area of the Suffolk Way car park, Sevenoaks which is directly managed by Sencio Community Leisure as part of the Sevenoaks Leisure Centre without the need to purchase or display a pay and display ticket. Such permits shall be displayed in the relevant position.

6.4 Other permits: any other permits which the Council may issue shall be used in accordance with the conditions specified at the time and shall be displayed in the relevant position.

d) the following were substituted for paragraph 2.36 of Article 2 in its entirety:

2.36 "relevant position" means:

In the case of a disabled person's badge:

the badge must be displayed on top of the dashboard or facia panel of the vehicle with the front of the badge (i.e. the side showing the wheelchair-user symbol) facing forward so that the relevant details are legible from outside of the vehicle. If the vehicle does not have a suitable dashboard or facia panel the badge must be exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle and in such a manner so that the relevant details are legible from outside the vehicle;

In the case of any other badge or permit:

i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge or permit is to be exhibited either on the windscreen, preferably on the nearside, with the front of the badge or permit facing forwards or on top of the dashboard or fascia panel so that all the relevant details are clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle;

ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is to be exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.

In all cases, the details on the front of the badge or permit must be clearly visible for inspection.

- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (3) The Order shall come into operation on 6th April 2010 and may be cited as the Sevenoaks District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Amendment No.2 Order 2010.
