

City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Normacot Alleyway Closures)
(No.8) Order 2011

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto at any time.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of March 2011, and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Normacot alleyway Closures) (No.8) Order 2011".

ALL VEHICLES PROHIBITED

Hamilton Road(Alleyway flanking Property No.1)

From a point 8 metres east of its junction with Hamilton Road for a distance of 0.5 metre in an easterly direction.

Buccleuch Road(Alleyway flanking Property No.24)

From a point 13.3 metres west of its junction with Buccleuch Road for a distance of 0.5 metres in a westerly direction.
