<u>City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Normacot Alleyway Closures)</u> (No.8) Order 2011

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto at any time.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform.
- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of March 2011, and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Normacot alleyway Closures) (No.8) Order 2011".

SCHEDULE ALL VEHICLES PROHIBITED

Hamilton Road(Alleyway flanking Property No.1)

From a point 8 metres east of its junction with Hamilton Road for a distance of 0.5 metre in an easterly direction.

Buccleuch Road(Alleyway flanking Property No.24)

From a point 13.3 metres west of its junction with Buccleuch Road for a distance of 0.5 metres in a westerly direction.
