

**CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (GOODSON STREET, MEIGH STREET,
BURTON PLACE)
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.99) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER, 2010**

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-**

1. Save as provided for in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit the unloading or loading of goods or merchandise to or from any vehicle between the hours of 8am and 8pm in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto..
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction of or with the permission of an on duty police officer.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary :-
 - a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle.
 - b) to enable the vehicle if it cannot be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said road of any sewer or main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus kept installed for the purpose of a Telecommunication code system or with any service provided by means of any such apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - c) to enable a vehicle of (and bearing a livery used by) a universal service provider within the meaning ascribed by the Postal Services Act 2000 to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the course of the provision of a universal postal service as defined in that Act.
 - d) to enable a vehicle if it cannot be used for such purposes in any road for the pursuance of statutory powers and duties.

The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applied for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of December 2010 for a period of 18 months and may be cited as "City Of Stoke-on-Trent (Goodson Street, Meigh Street, Burton Place) (Traffic Regulation) (No.99) Experimental Order, 2010".


