(NO. 1) ORDER 2013
(AMENDMENT NO. 6) ORDER 2021

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 35 36 45 46 49 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County (Various Roads in Waverley) (Residents' Only On-Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2013 (Amendment No. 6) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on 7 June 2021_____

- 2 (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Residents' Only On-Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2013_____
- (2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order byelaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment_____
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- (4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Principal Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order_____

3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Principal Order shall have effect as though -

- (a) The words "AND SHARED USE" were inserted in the heading for PART II in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following the Words "RESIDENTS' ONLY"
- (b) For the word "such" in the first and second items of PART II of the

Arrangement of Articles there were substituted the words “residents’ only”

- (c) The following items were added to the Arrangement of Articles

- (f) The words “and for a resident or carer in Resident Area T the letter “T” as indicated by the Council or the Borough Council” were added to the interpretation of the expression “the relevant indicator” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the phrase ““S” and indicated by the Council or the Borough Council” _____
- (g) The words “or the Ninth Part” was added to the interpretation of the expression “visitor” immediately following the words “Eighth Part” _____
- (h) The phrase “Article 4C and 4D and” was inserted in the interpretation of “waiver certificate” immediately following the words “purposes of” in paragraph (1) of Article 2
- (i) The following interpretations were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical sequence -
- ““Shepherds Hill Service Road Haslemere parking place” means that length of carriageway in Shepherds Hill Service Road Haslemere indicated as a residents parking place on the plans
- “Red Lion Lane Farnham parking place” means that length of Red Lion Lane Farnham indicated as a residents parking place on the plans
- (j) The words “and the Shepherds Hill Service Road Haslemere parking place and the Red Lion Lane Farnham parking place” were inserted in Article 3 immediately following the words “Haslemere parking place”
- (k) The following paragraphs were added to Article 3 immediately following paragraph (B)
- “(C) the area comprising the Shepherds Hill Service Road Haslemere parking place is designated as a residents’ only parking place

(D) the area comprising the Red Lion Lane Farnham parking place is designated as a residents' only parking place"

- (I) The following Articles numbered 4A and 4B and 4C and 4D were added to the principal Order immediately following Article 4

"Designation of shared use parking places

- 4A EACH area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a road identified on the plans for use by such classes of vehicles as are specified in Article 4B and unless otherwise so specified bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of no less than 1.8 metres is hereby designated as a shared use parking place

Vehicles for which shared use parking places are designated

- 4B EACH shared use parking place identified on the plans may be used subject to the provisions of this Order for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles only -
- (a) as are passenger vehicles goods vehicles motorcycles or invalid carriages or
 - (b) as display in the manner specified in Articles 23 or 27 or paragraph (7) of Article 29 or Article 34 a valid permit issued in respect of that vehicle

PROVIDED THAT nothing in this Article shall apply to a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority which may be left in the permit holders' parking place free of any charge imposed by this Order and without any limit on the period of time that that disabled person's vehicle may be left in the aforesaid shared use parking place

Period for which a vehicle may be left in a shared use parking place

- 4C WITHOUT prejudice to the provisions of Article 11 no person shall cause any vehicle to be left in a shared use parking place identified on the plans during the permitted hours for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in relation to that parking place as identified on the key relating to the plans:-

PROVIDED THAT nothing in this Article shall apply to -

- (a) a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority and/or
- (b) such vehicles as display in the manner specified in Articles 23 or 27 or

paragraph (7) of Article 29 or Article 34 a valid permit issued by the Council in respect of that vehicle and/or

- (c) such vehicles as display in a prominent position behind the windscreen so that it is facing forwards and can be entirely and easily seen from the front of the vehicle a valid Waiver Certificate issued by a person duly authorised by the Council to wait in accordance with the terms and conditions prescribed by the said certificate

PROVIDED THAT a Waiver Certificate may be cancelled at any time at the sole discretion of the Council and shall thereupon immediately cease to be valid and that a notification of such cancellation shall be sent by post to the holder of the certificate at any address which the Council believes to be that person's address and the certificate shall forthwith be surrendered to the Council

Interval before a vehicle may again be left in a shared use parking place

- 4D WITHOUT prejudice to the provisions of Article 11 no vehicle which has been taken away from a parking space (where such parking space is provided) in a shared use parking place identified on the plans during the permitted hours shall until the expiration of the period of time as is identified on the key on the said plans from the time it was taken away again be left in that parking place during the permitted hours:-

PROVIDED THAT nothing in this Article shall apply to -

- (a) such vehicles as display in the manner specified in Articles 23 or 27 or paragraph (7) of Article 29 or Article 34 a valid Permit issued in respect of that vehicle
- (b) a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority
- (c) such vehicles as display in a prominent position behind the windscreen so that it is facing forwards and can be entirely and easily seen from the front of the vehicle a valid Waiver Certificate issued by a person duly authorised by the Council to wait in accordance with the terms and conditions prescribed by the said certificate

PROVIDED THAT a Waiver Certificate may be cancelled at any time at the sole discretion of the Council and shall thereupon immediately cease to be valid and that a notification of such cancellation shall be sent by post to the holder of the certificate at any address which the Council believes to be that

person's address and the certificate shall forthwith be surrendered to the Council"

- (m) The words "or shared use parking place" was inserted in Article 5 and Article 7 and Article 8 and Article 9 and Article 10 and Article 11 and Article 12 and Article 13 and Article 14 and Article 15 and Article 16 and Article 17 and Article 18 and Article 22 and Article 23 and Article 25 and Article 27 and paragraphs (1) and (3) and (7) of Article 29 and paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 30 and Article 34 immediately following the words "residents only parking place" or "residents' parking place" as applicable wherever they appear_____
- (n) The words "or Shepherds Hill Service Road Haslemere parking place in Resident Area R or Red Lion Lane Farnham parking place in Resident Area T" were inserted in Article 5 and Article 6 and Article 7 and Article 13 and Article 18 and Article 23 and paragraph (3) of Article 29 and Article 30 and Article 34 immediately following the words "Kings Road (D5518) Haslemere parking place"_____
- (o) The words "or shared use parking place in accordance with Article 4B" were inserted in Article 10 immediately following the number "4"_____
- (p) The phrase "or Article 4B as the case may be" was inserted in Article 13(b) immediately following the number "4" _____
- (q) The phrase "or Resident Area T" was added to Article 18 and Article 25 immediately following the phrase "Resident Area S" wherever it appears_____
- (r) The words "or shared use parking place pursuant to Article 25" was inserted in Article 27 immediately following the words "residents' only parking place"____
- (s) The words "or shared use parking place pursuant to this Article" was inserted in paragraph (7) of Article 29 immediately following the words "residents' only parking place"_____
- (t) The words "and the Ninth Part" were added to paragraph (1) of Article 29 and paragraph (1) of Article 30 immediately following the words "Eighth Part"_____
- (u) The words "or the Ninth Part" were added to sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) of Article 29 immediately following the words "Eighth Part"_____
