THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF KENT (THE SQUARD, A.26, HADLOW) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER, 1965

The County Council of the Administrative County of Kent in excreise of their powers under subsections (1), (2) and (3) of section 25 and subsection (4) of section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and of all other powers snabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 6.50 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on that length of the south-east side of The Equare, A.26, Madlow, which extends from a point 34 yards west of the junction with Church Street for a distance of 36 yards in a south-westerly direction to a point in line with the party wall of the properties numbered 1 and 2 Castle Terrace.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the length of road specified in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose elsewhere, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of any roadworks or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus, for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports.
- 3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the designation of the latest of the latest latest of the latest latest
