(VARIOUS ROADS) (TUNBRIDGE WELLS BOROUGH)
(SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR) ORDER 2012
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and as amended by the Traffic Management Act 2004 Part 6 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

Interpretation

(1) In this Order:-

"civil enforcement area"	means an area where Civil Enforcement of parking restrictions can be enforced as defined in the Traffic Management Act 2004
"civil enforcement officer"	means a person employed by Tunbridge Wells Borough Council in pursuance of powers granted by the Traffic Management Act 2004 (Civil Enforcement Area)
"junction"	means the intersection point of the centrelines, or projected centrelines, of the roads specified
"owner" and "traffic sign"	have the same meanings as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984
"school keep clear"	Means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002
"specified road"	means the road or roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Prohibition of Stopping

- (2) Save as provided in Articles (3) of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden or of a civil enforcement officer cause or permit:-
- (a) any vehicle to stop Monday to Friday between the hours of 8am and 4pm in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order or
- (3) Nothing in Article (2) of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to stop in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
- (a) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such a purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of any local authority or with the permission of any such authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
- (b) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose elsewhere, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of any road works or the laying, erection and alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports; or
- (c) to enable the vehicle to be used for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes.
- (4) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984.
- (5) The provisions of this order shall prevail over the provisions of any previous order.

Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as "THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (TUNBRIDGE WELLS BOROUGH) (SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR) ORDER 2012" and shall come into operation on the 3rd September 2012.

Broomhill Park Road Southborough	south side	from a point 114 metres west of its junction with Prospect Road to a point 144 metres west of that junction
Claremont Road Tunbridge Wells	east side	from its junction with Poona Road to a point 44 metres south of that junction
Common Road Sissinghurst	south west side	From a point 22 metres south east of its junction with the vehicle access to the school to a point 22 metres north west of that point
Cunningham Road Tunbridge Wells	west side	from its most southerly point to a point 44 metres north of that point
Five Oak Green Road Capel	north side	from a point 26 metres east of its junction with Church Road to a point 70 metres east of that junction
Forest Road Paddock Wood	north east side	from a point 8 metres south east of its junction with Birch Road to point 18 metres north west of that junction
Friars Way Tunbridge Wells	south side	from a point 13 metres east of its junction with the vehicle access to the school to a point 13 metres west of that junction
Greggs Wood Road Tunbridge Wells	west side	from a point 11 metres north of the vehicle access to the school to a point 15 metres south of that access
Langton Road Speldhurst	west side	from a point 87 metres south of its junction with Penshurst Road to a point 129 metres south of that junction
Lower Green Road Pembury	west side	from a point 22 metres north of its junction with The Forstal to a point 49 metres north of that junction
Orchard Crescent Horsmonden	north side	from a point 64 metres east of its junction with Back Lane to a point 90 metres east of that junction
Queen Street Sandhurst	north side	from a point 19 metres east of its junction with the vehicle access to the school to a point 19 metres west of that junction
Rusthall High Street Rusthall	south side	from a point 13 metres east of its junction with the vehicle access to the school to a point 13 metres west of that

Sandrock Road Tunbridge Wells	south side	from a point 65 metres west of its junction with Shrublands Court to a point 109 metres west of that junction
The Street Frittenden	west side	from its junction with the vehicle access to the school to a point 44 metres south of that junction
Wilman Road Tunbridge Wells	west side	from a point 16 metres north of its junction with the vehicle access to the school to a point 16 metres south of that access
Windmill Street Tunbridge Wells	west side	from its most southerly point to a point 26 metres north of that point
