THE WIGAN BOROUGH (DECRIMINALISATION OF PARKING) **(VARIOUS ROADS IN WIGAN BOROUGH)** **(TRAFFIC REGULATION CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2004** **(AMENDMENT NO. 9) ORDER 2007**

The Wigan Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order which will come into operation on 5th March 2007.

1. This Order may be cited as The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No. 9) Order 2007 and shall come into operation on 5th March 2007.
2. The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 is hereby amended as follows:
 - a. In relation to Schedule One the following entries shall be added to Schedule One to the Order:-

Tram Street, Platt Bridge	Both	Its junction with Wigan Street	A point 15 metres south west of Wigan Street
---------------------------	------	--------------------------------	--

Tram Street, Platt Bridge	Both	Its junction with Wigan Street	A point 15 metres north east of Wigan Street
---------------------------	------	--------------------------------	--

Wigan Street, Platt Bridge	Both	Its junction with Tram Street	A point 15 metres north west of Tram Street
----------------------------	------	-------------------------------	---

Wigan Street, Platt Bridge	Both	Its junction with Tram Street.	A point 15 metres south east of Tram Street

3. Save as provided in relation to the above amendments The Wigan Borough (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 shall remain in force.
