WIGAN BOROUGH(DECRIMINALISATION OF PARKING) (VARIOUS ROADS IN WIGAN BOROUGH) (TRAFFIC REGULATION CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2004 (AMENDMENT NO.212) ORDER 2011

Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004, hereby makes the following Order

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.212) Order 2011 and shall come into operation on **5 December 2011**
- 2. Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (as amended) is hereby further amended as follows:-
 - (a) In relation to Schedule One, Prohibition of Waiting at any time, the following entries shall be **deleted** from Schedule One to the Order:-

(b) In relation to Schedule One, Prohibition of Waiting at any time, the following entries shall be added to Schedule One to the Order:-

Kid Glove Road, Golborne	East	its junction with High Street	a point 99 metres north of its junction with High Street
Kid Glove Road, Golborne	East	A point 124 metres north of its junction with High Street	Its cul de sac end

3. Save as provided in relation to the above amendments Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (as amended) shall remain in force.
